**Basic Homicide Investigators Course

The International Homicide Investigators Association (IHIA) is sponsoring a **40-hour Basic Homicide Investigators Course** hosted by the **Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office**. The program is scheduled for **Monday October 21, 2013 thru Friday October 25, 2013 at the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office Training Academy located at 1801 West Bank Expressway in Harvey, Louisiana.**

This course of instruction is designed to improve and enhance the abilities of the homicide investigator through the introduction of a core minimum standard of training, while also introducing updates, changes in the law and new advancements in technology.

Topics include: Responsibilities of the Homicide Investigator, Duties of the First Responder, Crime Scene Analysis, Homicide Types & Offender Motivation, Crime Scene Processing, Laboratory Capabilities & Evidence Processing, Role of the Coroner/Medical Examiner, Investigative Resources & Techniques, Serial Murders, Interview & Interrogation, Suspect Development & Elimination, Death Notifications, Victimology, Case Management, Documentation & Report Writing, Media Relations, Prosecution & Legal Matters, Ethics and Stress Management.

Who Should Attend: Any Detective, Homicide Investigator, Crime Scene Technician, Coroner/Medical Examiner's Investigator, Prosecutor, First Responder or Supervisor who are tasked with investigating homicides or any other acts of violent criminal activity.

The Cost of this course is \$350.00, which includes a binder with all instruction materials and handouts, a one-year membership in the IHIA, Course Certificates, an IHIA ID Card, and daily refreshments.

Networking is optional but highly recommended!
